



GIVING BACK TO KICKBACK YOUTH HOMELESSNESS

Between 1.6 and 2.6 million youth run away in a given year and over 400 struggling youth enter the Sea Haven programs annually.

Sea Haven Inc. is the only emergency crisis residential program in Horry County for runaway, homeless, struggling youth ages 13-17 years. The Shelter program is licensed by the Department of Social Services, consisting of 9 beds for emergency short term services.

We are truly fortunate to start the construction process for a newer modern facility which will provide housing for more youth. In cost savings efforts, we are asking for your support with the new project.

ADOPT-A-ROOM

The "Adopt-A-Room" project will give individuals or groups the opportunity to furnish a room with all the necessary items. The new home will have 8 potential bedrooms, 2 beds per room, 8 bathrooms, dining room, living room, computer game room and a wrap-around porch on the front of the home. It is the vision of Sea Haven to have 4 bedrooms for males and 4 bedrooms for females; however, it may be unknown how many youth will be in the program at specific times.
